The minister welcomes the candidate(s) into the local and universal Church, stressing the importance of belonging to the Christian community, the responsibilities of parents and godparents, and the challenge of growing in Christian discipleship.

President Faithful and loving God, bless those who care for these children and grant them your gifts of love. wisdom and faith. Pour upon them your healing and reconciling love, and protect their homes from all evil. Fill them with the light of your presence and establish them in the joy of your kingdom. through Jesus Christ our Lord.

President God of grace and life, in your love you have given us a place among your people; keep us faithful to our baptism, and prepare us for that glorious day when the whole creation will be made perfect in your Son our Saviour Jesus Christ. Amen.

Presentation of the Candidate(s)

The Decision

The president addresses the candidate through the parents, godparents and sponsors.

Signing with the Cross

The president makes the sign of the cross on the forehead of each candidate, saying

Prayer over the Water

The ministers and candidates gather at the baptismal font if they have not already done so. The president stands before the water of baptism.

President	Praise God who made heaven and earth,
All	who keeps his promise for ever.

- All It is right to give thanks and praise.
- **President** We praise you, loving Father, for the gift of your Son Jesus. He was baptized in the River Jordan, where your Spirit came upon him and revealed him as the Son you love. He sent his followers to baptize all who

turn to him. Now, Father, we ask you to bless this water, that those who are baptized in it may be cleansed in the water of life, and, filled with your Spirit, may know that they are loved as your children, safe in Christ for ever.

Profession of Faith

The president addresses those assembled.

President	Let us affirm, together with <i>these</i> who <i>are</i> being baptized, our common faith in Jesus Christ.
All	Do you believe and trust in God the Father, source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist? I believe and trust in him.
All	Do you believe and trust in God the Son, who took our human nature, died for us and rose again? I believe and trust in him.
All	Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world? I believe and trust in him.
President All	This is the faith of the Church. This is our faith. We believe and trust in one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.
